

Issue #696: Images on Websites won't load with Zinc add-on and Firefox

Description

I am using Zinc 0.6.3.0 and Firefox 2.0.0.14 and Linux Ubuntu 7.10 Gutsy. If the Zinc add-on is activated, then the images on websites won't load. The broken link symbol appears. Even right-clicking and choosing "View images" results in an error message. This is no longer the case when Zinc is disabled.

Deactivating the add-on's one by one did not have any effect on the images. I also should add that it might not be a new 'bug' since I did not use my desktop within the last two weeks.

The error message is for a particular example: The image

because it contains errors.
